### GRADUATE CREDIT COURSE EDSP 670 SCMEA IN-SERVICE CONFERENCE, FEBRUARY 6-8, 2020

Welcome to Columbia and the 2020 SCMEA In-Service Conference. This year's conference promises to be especially exciting. Please read below the requirements and process for obtaining graduate credit through Furman University for this workshop.

#### 1. Attend 15 clock hours of sessions.

In addition to regular sessions, you may count concerts, banquets (if there is a program and a speaker), divisional business meetings, and exhibit time viewing curricular materials.

- 2. <u>Keep a diary of the events you attend</u>. Provide me with a document that includes a BRIEF 3-4 sentence summation and critique of each event you attend. (REQUIRED) This does not need be a lengthy transcript, but rather a synopsis of the things you learned or observed at each event. Please write your observations with full sentences in paragraph form. Evaluate the sessions as you deem appropriate, but a <u>possible line</u> of thought may be:
  - 1) Which clinician did you think was most effective and why?
  - 2) Did you hear any new music or find materials that would be effective in your teaching situation?
  - 3) Did you gather any advice or materials on advocacy that can assist you in your teaching situation?
  - 4) Would you recommend the clinician to a colleague?
  - 5) How did the conference/session help you grow as a musician a/o teacher?

Because of the reduced fee structure for this year's course, there will be no faculty response to the document you present.
