Guidelines for the Piano Festival

1. Students can choose to perform two solo pieces from memory or one solo piece from memory and one duet/ensemble piece. Students may also choose to perform one duet/ensemble piece.
2. Standard classical repertoire is acceptable. No scales or technical studies are required.
3. The grading for the Festival is self-contained; success does not lead to a state, regional or national competition. The grading is based on the individual student's level of accomplishment.
4. Each student will receive a grade for their performance. The grading scale is Superior, Excellent, Good, and Fair. Students will also receive written comments and a certificate of participation.
5. Students may be chosen to perform in the Piano Division Student Honors Recital on May 22, 2021. This event may be live or virtual, depending on the conditions of the pandemic. The students who are chosen will be selected, based on musicality, expressivity, and preparedness of their pieces, by Piano Festival judges.
6. Teachers will include unlisted YouTube link(s) on the registration form for video submissions.
7. If a teacher wishes to submit the registration online, they may send their fee to "SCMEA Piano Division" via PayPal. Submissions without a registration fee will not be judged.
